words on The Word

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On September 3 we had our first school mass with the students and Teachers of Divine Savior School. It was a joy to see the kids and their teachers, and especially to welcome new students. When I visited each of the classrooms later that morning, to see how the first day of school is going, the positive energy, the good vibes and zest was palpable. The hugs received and high fives exchanged with the kids were particularly warm and joyful.

Our new principal, Mr. Anton Shircel, and all the teachers have worked so hard to prepare for a new school year. I am excited for our parishes to continue to work with them to support and sustain our cherished Divine Savior School. As I have said in the past, Divine Savior School is a daughter institution whose mother is our tri-parish faith community. We have every reason to look forward to a successful school year.

It seemed like yesterday, however, when the school kids and their teachers went for the summer vacation. Where has the time gone? Where did the summer go? Time, they say waits for nobody. I remember that when I was in grade school in Nigeria, one of the poems we had to memorize and recite each day, had these lines, "Tick, says the clock, tick, tick/ What you got to do, do quick."

Even today, it reminds me that I do not literally have all day, and that time should not be wasted. What good I need to do, should be done today. What forgiveness do I need to offer, or peace made, should be done today – not tomorrow. A beautiful line from Psalm 90 expresses this **prayer: "teach us to number our days** aright, that we may gain wisdom of **heart" (Ps. 90: 12).** The Tuesday of our first school mass was also the feast of St. Gregory the Great, who was a Pope and Doctor of the Church. He was a figure of great wisdom who taught the church's faithful with his preaching, teaching and writing. He is considered one of the four Great Latin Doctors of the Church. He was the first to call himself, "Servant of the Servants of God," a title still used to date by the Popes. The other three Latin doctors are Saints Augustine, Ambrose and Jerome. Did you know that a stain glass window was dedicated to each of these four doctors of the Church at Holy Rosary Church? It is worthwhile to see them. St. Gregory used the time given to him by God, to make a difference in the Church and the world of his time. We are called to do the same.
