words on *The Word*

by Father Amadi

Dear friends in Christ,

At every Mass we pray the Anima Christ (Soul of Christ) as a prayer of Thanksgiving after Holy Communion. It is a beautiful prayer attributed to St. Ignatius of Loyola who founded the religious order called the Society of Jesus, also known as the Jesuits. During this period of thanksgiving, I thought it might be a good idea to share with you this insight into the words of this prayer as put together by Fr. Jack Wintz, OFM.

A blessed Thanksgiving to you and yours!

Gratefully in Christ, Fr. Alvan Amadi

Breaking the *Anima Christi* down line-by-line, reflecting briefly on each of them.

Soul of Christ, sanctify me. O Jesus, may your soul—vast as the universe—invade my whole being and draw me closer to you.

Body of Christ, save me. I open myself to your love. Embrace me with your healing and transforming power. I am especially moved by this prayer when I reflect on it after receiving the body and blood of Christ at Holy Communion—or after Mass has ended.

Blood of Christ, inebriate me. You have redeemed me, Jesus, by your blood shed upon the cross. At the Eucharist, I receive that blood in the form of wine. Your burning love is so overwhelming that I become intoxicated by the intensity of your love for me.

Water from the side of Christ, wash me. Yes, Jesus, let the water flowing from your side cleanse me, as did the life-giving water that flowed over me at Baptism. And may this saving stream never stop flowing through me!

Passion of Christ, strengthen me. It is your power, and not my own, that heals me and makes me strong. As the psalmist says, **“Unless the LORD build the house, they labor in vain who build” (Ps 127:1).**

Your strength alone is my source of hope.

O good Jesus, hear me. Within your wounds hide me. I experience something very mystical and intimate, Jesus, when I hide there.

Permit me not to be separated from you. Loving Savior, these words express for me the most central theme of the Anima Christi. Keep me aware that this is not so much a gaining of information about you, O Jesus, as it is a growing into a more intimate love union with you.

From the wicked foe, defend me. These words are similar to the closing words of the Our Father, which teach me to say: **“Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.” Loving Lord, set me free** from any malignant force that separates me from you—and from life itself!

At the hour of my death, call me, and bid me come to you that, with your saints, I may praise you for ever and ever. Amen. Jesus, I need your help to reach my final destination in your heavenly kingdom. Stay with me to the end so I can join in singing your praises with all who are saved by your overflowing and immense love!

Faith Formation Program

It takes a village. A group of parents have organized and are leading a brand new confirmation program that starts with the students their junior year. It's using content from Matthew Kelly and Fr. Mike Schmitz, utilizing on-line videos and small group discussions, and hopes to help students build a relationship with Jesus. Classes are on Wednesday nights from 6:00-9:00pm.

They start with a meal because a) we know kids are coming from sports/other activities and b) it's an opportunity to connect and continue to build relationships.

They are using the gathering space at Meiselwitz Funeral Home for classes, as it is a large enough space for this group to meet as a whole and to break out into small groups. There is also a small kitchen area where meals can be set up and served.

Interested in helping? They need small group leaders and food. The role of the small group leader will be to ask ques-

tions, encourage dialogue, and listen. That's it! You will have a list of questions to help you get started, as well. With 18 kids, 3 small group leaders are needed each class to make this work.

We also need a meal for 18 students. We have two students with nut allergies and one with a tree nut allergy. They have a supply of bottled water, as well as plates, silverware and napkins. And each night we share a snack, so we're looking for individual snacks. Rice Krispie bars, cookies, beef & cheese sticks, pretzels or animal cookies are all good examples.

Our faith community is a family of God made up of everyday people coming together to offer assistance, support and uplift one another. You're just who we need!

Want to help out, either as a group leader, by making a meal or providing a snack? Please reach out to Kim in the office for open dates. And feel free to forward this note to grandparents or others you feel would be a good faith example and would be good at/enjoy leading a discussion or baking a snack!

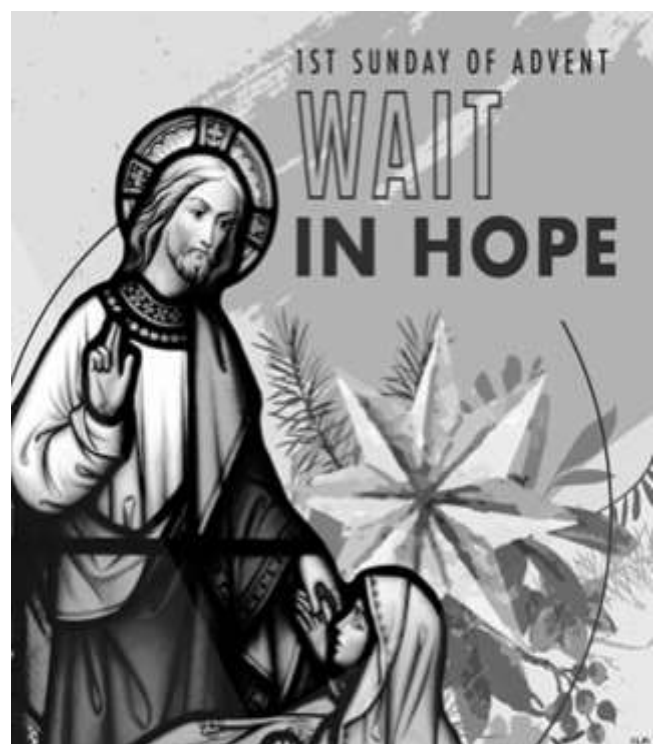
