I realize we're halfway into the

month of December and we may be hoping our first significant snow fall is weeks (can we hope for months!?) away, but we all know that our weather can change very quickly here in Wisconsin. As **they say, if you don't like the weather, just wait five minutes. We've already had** to cancel our faith formation in December because of a pop-up snow storm.

In an effort to be prepared, I wanted to pass along to you our plan if a snow storm were to come our way on a weekend. If we find ourselves faced with that situation in the days or months to come, here is how we will respond and here is where you may check to see if Mass will be celebrated at any of our three parishes:



Deacon Dennis and I will attempt to make the decision to cancel Mass as early as possible. My goal will be 2 to 3 hours prior to our Mass on Saturday (so between 1:00 and 2:00 p.m.) or by 6:00 a.m. on Sunday.



We will put the closing on our **churches' facebook pages.**



We will ask Lynne or Kim to put the **information on the linked parish's** website.

(www.threeparishesonefaith.com).



We will contact the following TV stations with the information - channels 2, 5 & 11.

Regardless of the weather, Mass will always be celebrated at Holy Rosary on their scheduled day & time because I can walk over to church.

Regarding weekday activities and snow-fall - if schools are cancelled or released early on any given Wednesday due to the weather, Faith Formation classes will also be cancelled that evening. If the weather causes a delay in school start times, that weekday morning liturgy will also be cancelled.

More than anything else, I just ask you to use your good sense.

*If you feel unsafe on the roads, stay at home. We can always bring Eucharist to you during the week and would much rather do so than seeing **you place yourselves in harm's way.***

Christmas Marshmallows by Kristina M. DeNeve

There was a wonderful study conducted decades ago in which three year-olds had a large marshmallow placed in front of them. They were told if they could wait five minutes (a lifetime for them!) they would get a second marshmallow to eat along with the first.

Tracking these children through life, the researchers discovered that those who learned to delay gratification tended to be better adjusted into adulthood, with fewer divorces and longer tenure in their jobs and so forth.

Waiting is never easy, but it is always worthwhile! And, so it is for us in these final days of Advent, as we wait for the coming of the feasts, the presents, the laughter, and yes, waiting for the fullness of life that is promised through Jesus Christ. Like Joseph, however, we typically will also have to let go of our expectations. Wait and make space, knowing the promise of the incarnation eventually comes.
